# About Lynda

My name is Lynda Graveline and I am the face behind L Graveline Photography.

Having a photographer that specializes in pets means that we see the little things that make your photo special. The look in their eyes when they are 'on', that face they make that you fall in love with, and their cute little features that make your smile. It's not enough for me to get a well-shot photo, I want you to be able to feel your pet's soul through the image so that you can look back on it and smile for years to come.

# The Process

1. Let's Chat! Reach out to me and let me know what your vision is (if you have one) or if you'd like me to help you put something together. I've got TONS of locations to choose from or if you've already got a spot in mind, let me know a bit about it.
2. Let's shoot! Once we've set our date and time we're ready to get started. For outdoor shoots, I generally try to aim for sunrise or sunset so we can get the best images of your pet. We'll spend about an hour at our location. If we luck out with an overcast day, we can shoot at any time. We'll touch base closer to the date!
3. Time for magic. This is the retouching and post-production phase which happens after the photoshoot is all complete and you have returned home. Images will be sorted and the best of the best will undergo a first-round edit so you can begin to see where the end result magic will be.

4. Once the first-round edit is finished you'll receive an online gallery with 20-25 images to choose from. Once you've decided which photos you would like, I'll get them ready with an extra special touch to share with the world! The final stage edit will produce one-of-a-kind photos of your dog that you can cherish for a lifetime.

5. Once you've had a chance to look over the photos and select the ones you'd like it's time to decide if you wish to purchase prints/wall art or any additional images. We have a huge selection of professionally printed pieces to choose from. There is never ever any pressure to purchase any additional image, product or otherwise, but this step is here if you would like to.

6. They're all yours! The final step in the experience for you is the delivery of any photographic products that you selected with in step 5 above. If at all possible, I prefer to personally deliver prints and wall-art in person so we can make sure it arrives in one piece!

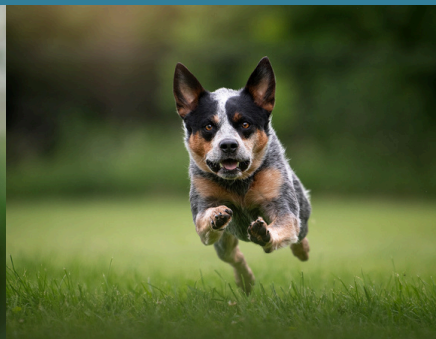
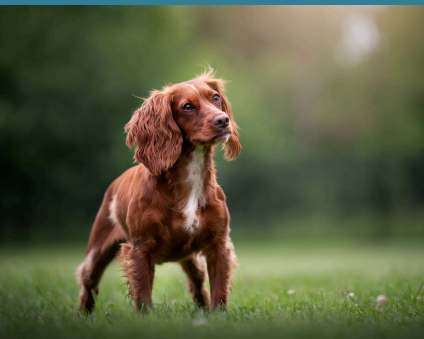


# The Session

Your session is designed to be a fun and stress-free experience.

Lynda deals with many dogs from many backgrounds from puppies with zero obedience skills to highly trained athletes and everything in between. If you think your dog isn't trained enough for this shoot, think again! This shoot is for any dog that enjoys being outside and spending time in nature. Dogs do NOT need to be off leash, and we can accommodate any special needs your dog has, including reactivity. Reactive dogs deserve good photos too!

For your session you'll want to bring water, lots of high-value treats your dog enjoys, and a toy if they have one they like. We'll work within your dogs skill set, leashed or unleashed. If you want to show off some of their cute tricks please let us know - I love these! You and your dog will receive plenty of breaks in between shootings as we explore various spots at our chosen location.



# Clothing & Styling

**Here are some quick tips for those interested in being in the photos with your pets. This is always encouraged, even if it's just a couple!**

I always suggest wearing something comfortable, first and foremost. If you aren't comfortable it will show in the photos. Make sure you dress for the weather and will not be either too hot or too cold. If you'd like to wear something other than a winter coat in the colder seasons, make sure your coat fits over top of your outfit so you can walk to the location.

When in doubt, solid colours are always a great choice with the exception of plaid in the fall. For winter and fall, coordinating scarves, hats and mittens are always a nice touch

## **Dog Coat Colour Guide**

- **Solid black dogs:** Colourful or muted colours, try to avoid wearing black or grey if possible.
- **Tri-coloured dogs:** Muted tones such as olive, burgundy, navy, or plaid.
- **Red dogs:** Warm tones or earth tones. Olive green, burgundy and navy are always a good option.
- **Heavily patterned dogs such as brindle or merle:** Solid colours are especially important.
- **Blue or grey dogs:** cool tones such as black, blues and greys look stunning.
- **Multi-coloured packs:** Solid colours are always a safe bet!
